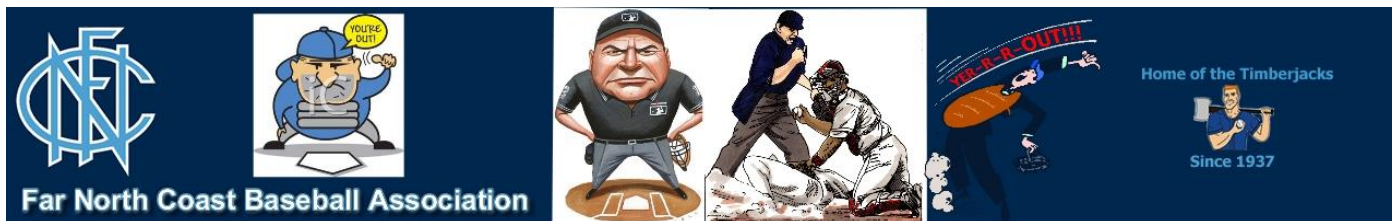

PROTEST DURING A GAME

Protesting Club

I/We wish to lodge a protest about an incident during a game.

- Advise the Umpire-in-Chief of the nature of the protest, time innings, score. Record on result card and scorebooks.
- Within two working after the game, forward *FNCBA Inc. Protest Form* to the Secretary (*FNCBA Inc. Contact Schedule*) include all relevant details of the protest.
- Include with the request cheque/cash for \$50

What must we do?

- Immediately copy details of the protest onto game card
