

Far North Coast Baseball Association Regional Direct Coaching (RDC)

Role description

The RDC is a board appointed position that will be appointed every two years at the FNCBA Annual General Meeting.

The RDC primary roles and responsibilities are as follows;

- Develop and deliver training for FNCBA coaches at all levels provide advice to club and representative coaches as required
- Provide recommendation to the board with regard to selection of representative coaching positions and provide assistance and advice into the development of training programs for representative teams.
- Assist in the delivery of representative training programs and high performance programs for FNC players who maybe selected in state or national representative teams (working with the nominate state or national coaches).
- Sign off on requests for juniors playing up and down grades for FNCBA club games
- Develop a “best practice” framework for FNCBA with regard to training programs and coaching (including age appropriate return to throw programs) and provide guidance for coaching staff at all levels.
- Organise and conduct a coaches meeting prior to the beginning of each season/representative program (or as required by the board) to discuss approaches and provide advice
- Develop and deliver high performance programs for FNCBA
